Scuba diving in cenotes is a unique experience that is like floating in space on another planet. The serenity and beauty of these underworlds and their ancient rock formations provide a unique, almost mystical experience. Each cenote has its own beauty and character. We choose the dive sites according to your experience. Don't miss your opportunity to witness this unique natural phenomenon.

# **Reef diving Tulum:**

There is great reef scuba diving sites near Tulum located at depths between 12 and 30 m. Tulum is part of the 2nd biggest coral barrier reef in the world. These sites include many coral canyons with a height of about 10 m that are covered with colorful and healthy corals of many types. You will see lots of elkhorn coral and volcano sponges and reef fish. It is also possible to see lobsters, crabs, eels, and rays in the clear, warm Caribbean waters.

## **Coba Wild Monkey Sactuary:**

Begin your day exploring the mighty Coba archaelogical site on a bicycle or friendly Mayan bike taxi (Included). Leave a triumphant mark on your day by climbing the mighty Nohoch Mul Pyramid, the tallest in the northern Yucatan (not mandatory).

Connect with nature knowing that your visit economically contributes to the fight faced by local Mayan inhabitants to defend their ancestral lands from deforestation. Finish this gripping

experience with a gourmet beachside lunch.

Explore old- growth jungles inhabited by wild howler and spider monkeys. Zip-line over an amazingly picturesque lagoon and swim in a truly sacred cenote.
